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#### ABOUT THE PROJECT

The civic dimensions for social inclusion project (**CivicAL**) will address the gap in civic education for adults in disadvantaged situation in 6 European countries, reflecting on the importance of extra-curricular aspects of AE within the frames of a multicultural European environtment.

Our target disadvantaged adults from migrant or ethnic minority backgrounds, who are often being offered language and professional skills, but are lacking the knowledge on EU citizenship and culture, values and democratic principles, followed by the European societies. For their better social inclusion, labour integration and participation in the EU civic life.

At least 30 % of the participants in the project activities will be people with fewer opportunities, facing sorne social, economic obs- tacles or cultural differences.

They will be selected locally, in collaboration with the social services and training centres authorized by the State to provide help and Support to these target groups.

The Project will develop the following products:

- -A Trainer's Manual "Civic Education for Disadvantaged Learners" in 6 EU languages.
- -An EU citizenship game, available in 6 EU languages, offering 6 playing levels. Through the game, the player will step into different roles while learning about the concepts of civic education.

CivicAL Project foresees 4 transnational meeting, approximately every 6 months of the Project execution to ensure regular monitoring, evaluation and follow— up of the implemented activities as well as National meetings in Bulgaria and Cyprus and Regional meetings in Romania and Italy.

The project will also delivers flyers,e-newsletters, website, social media & an ethical code.
